BOWSER GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act. Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894) the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser Models-Fig. 2500, 2501, 2500B, 2501B, 2500F, 2501F, 2500FS and 2501FS, manufactured by S.F. Bowser Limited, 344 Sherman Avenue, North., Hamilton, Ontario.

Rating:

12 Gallons per minute maximum.

Application:

Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.

Conditions:

As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description:

These devices are computing type gasoline dispensers equipped with a redesigned Veeder-Root registering head with semi-automatic set back and is equipped with an interlocking device. The air elimator is located within the extended meter casing. The meter adjustment wheel has been redesigned for finer adjustment and the pump is of the wane type. Fig. 2500 and 2501 differ only in the means of hose retraction. The model number suffix letters indicate that the dispenser is equipped as follows:

B- dispenser equipped with remote pump.

F- dispenser equipped with filter.

FS-dispenser equipped with filter and water separator.

Testing:

The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
