APPROVAL LISTING

GILBERT AND BARKER GASOLINE DISPENSER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894) the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser, Model 1002 H.G. with a maximum capacity of 18 gallons per minute, manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Company, 64 Jefferson Avenue., Toronto, Ontario.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: This device is a computing dispenser similar to Model 1006 (SD-WA.258) with the following exceptions:

- (1) The motor capacity is 3/4 H.P.
- (2) The air separator is the same as Model 914 (SD-WA.147)
- (3) Piping and hose is 1" diameter.
- (4) Veeder-Root register has greater capacity.
- (5) Counter set back is operated manually.

The dispenser is provided with an interlocking device.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
