ERIE MARINE AND FLIGHT FUELER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: A computing fuel dispenser, Model 140-16 menufactured by Erie

Meter Systems Inc., Erie, P.A. U.S.A.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 G.P.M.

Application:

Dispensing fuel to Marine craft and small aircraft.

Conditions:

As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description:

This device is a fuel dispenser equipped with a remote pumping unit and 50 feet of hose which is retracted within the housing by a hand operated chain drive reel, a Veeder-Root registering head is installed which calculates to \$99.99 and redictors to 999.9 gallons. The Eric meter is a standard one inch meter with two opposed double acting pistons. The dispenser is equipped with a micro filter for eliminating water. The inlet control valve, switch and registering head are interlocked. The remote pumping units which may be used with this dispenser ere:

Erie remote cabinet or chassis type, submerged turbine type or

the "Removo" submersible type.

Testing:

The standard tests for either retail or wholesale use or both shall apply depending on the quantities delivered in trade.
