APPROVAL LISTING

WAYNE BLEND-O-MATIC GASOLINE DISPENSER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Blend-O-Matic computing gasoline dispenser with remote pumping unit Model 511-D-1, manufactured by the Wayne Pump Company, 829 Richmond Street West, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum capacity twelve gallons per minute.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.


Description: This device is a gasoline dispenser designed to dispense nine grades of gasoline, seven of these grades are blends of the two basic fuels.

The dispenser is of the same basic design as Model 511-D listed on SD-WA. 332 except for changes as follows:

- (1) The combined pump, motor, air eliminator unit is submerged in the supply tank.
- (2) Solenoid valves controlled by the dispenser starting handle are located upstream adjacent to the meters.

Testing: The standard tests for a blend-o-matic dispenser shall apply.
