WAYNE - GASOLINE DISPENSERS

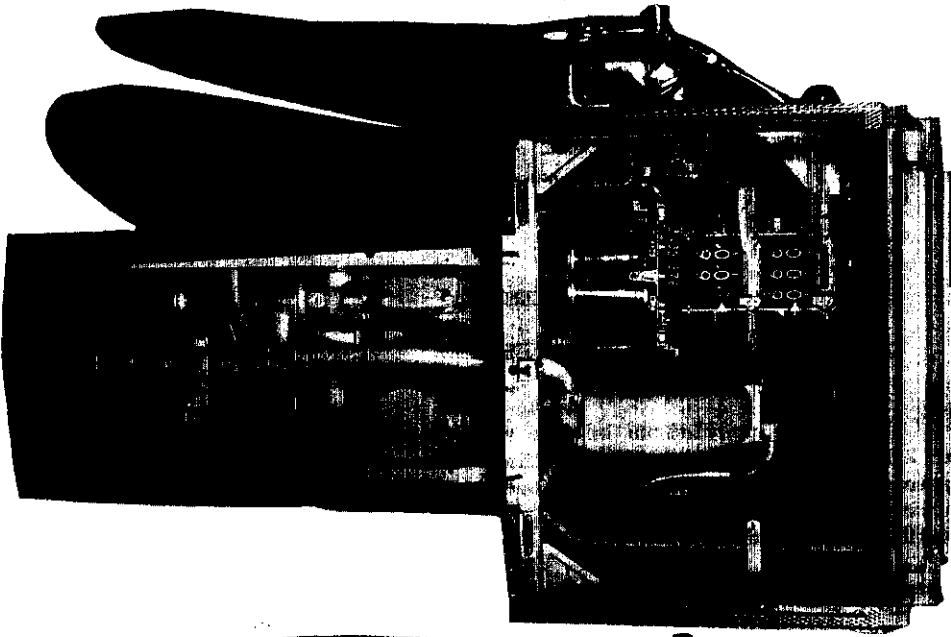
Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

- Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensers Models 714B, 714B-1, 715B-1, 716B-1, 734B, 734B-1, 735B-1, 736B-1. Central figure 1 means unlighted and figure 3 means equipped with lights. Letter B means suction pump unit and B-1 means remote units. 716B-1 and 736B-1 are twin units with remote pumps, manufactured by Wayne Pump Company, 629 Richmond Street, West, Toronto, Ontario.
- Rating of Apparatus: Maximum 15 G.P.M.
- Application: Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.
- Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.
- Description: These devices are of a new outward design as shown by the pictures on the reverse side of this circular. However, the component parts are very similar to previous models 511D shown on SD-WA.332.
- Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.

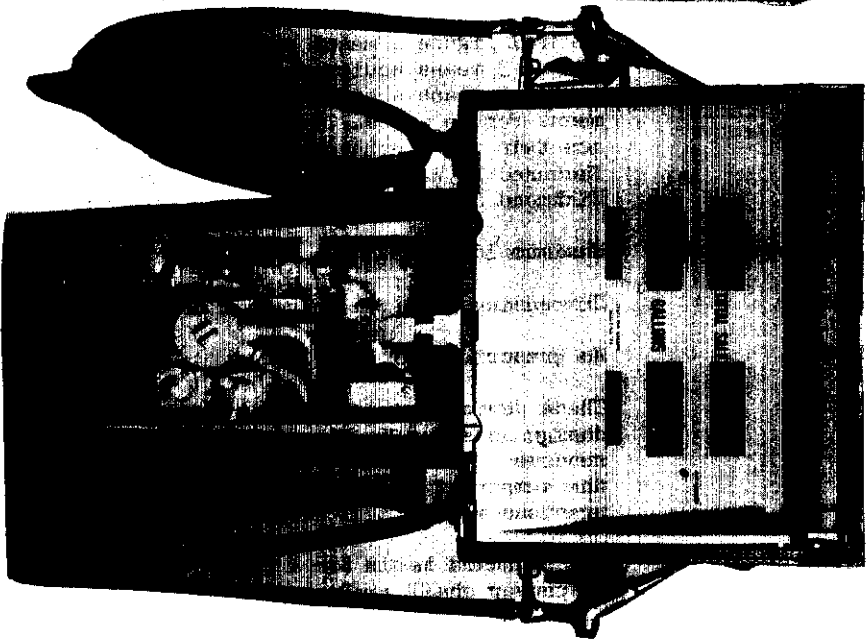
