GILBERT AND BARKER - GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Oil and Gas mixing pumps, Models 122-160 oil ratios 25:1 and 20:1, 332-110 oil ratios 24:1 and 20:1, and 332-010 oil ratios 24:1 and 20:1 with remote pumping unit.

Manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Company, 64 Jefferson Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 G. P. M. maximum.


Application: For serving marine engines and others where an oil and gasoline mixture is required, but can be used to serve gasoline alone.

Conditions: As prescribed in P. C. 6894.

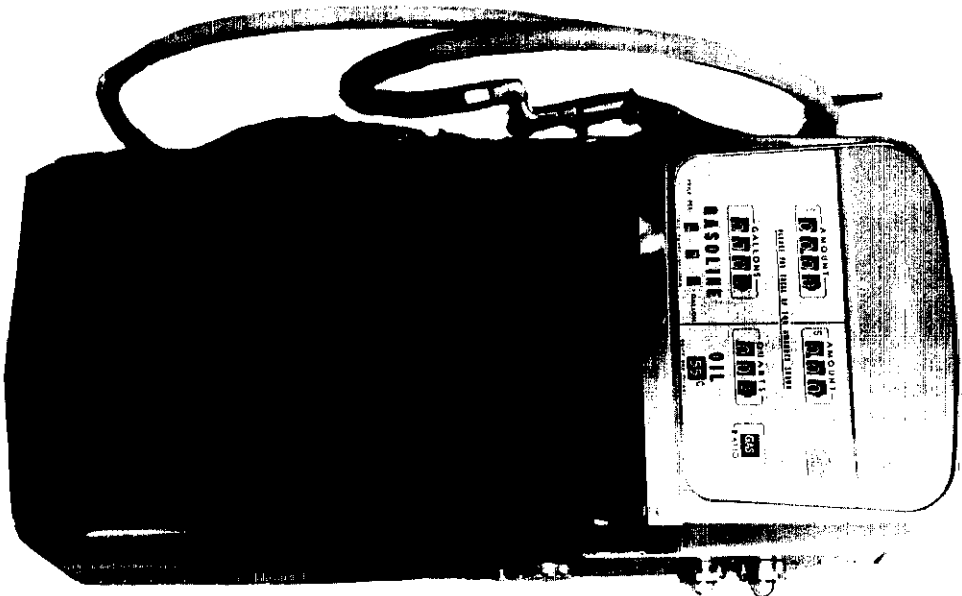
Description: These are gasoline and oil mixing pumps at fixed ratios, (1) Gasoline (2) Gasoline and Oil 20:1 ratio, (3) Gasoline and Oil 25:1 ratio. The oil supply is in a storage compartment within the unit and a larger storage adjacent. This oil level is interlocked so that if the oil reaches the low limit, the pump locks and cannot be operated. The price of gasoline and the price of oil are posted separately and computed separately. The value of the sale is the total of the computed price of both the oil and gasoline recorders. The type of mixture is determined by a selector switch on the outside of the pump.

Testing: Standard tests for two blend dispensers with inspection fee of \$4.00 to apply.

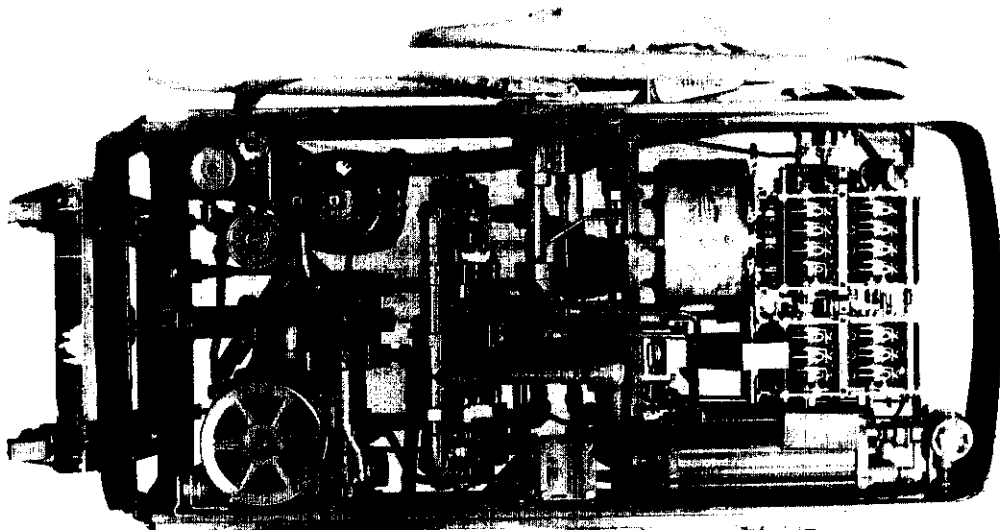
