APPROVAL LISTING

BOWSER - RETAIL GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensers, Models: Fig. 4800, Fig. 4800B, Fig. 4800F and Fig. 4800 FS manufactured by S.A. Bowser Limited, 344 Sherman Avenue, North, Hamilton, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 G.P.M. maximum with 1/3 H.P. motor, 15 G.P.M. maximum with 1/2 H.P. motor.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: These devices are computing type gasoline dispensers equipped with Veeder Root semi-automatic resetting computing head. The dispenser uses the same parts and the assembly is essentially the same as Fig. 2501 listed on SD-WA.327 except that lighting arrangements have been eliminated, the height of the dispenser has been reduced, sight glass relocated, single action zero return installed and the reading face of the unit is slanted. The Model suffix letters indicate that the dispenser is equipped as follows:

- B - dispenser equipped with remote pump.
- F - dispenser equipped with filter.
- FS - dispenser equipped with filter and water separator.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
