GILBERT AND BARKER - GASOLINE DISPENSER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Non-computing gasoline dispenser Models CFP201D-15 and CFP202E-15 with capacities of 12 G.F.M. and 18 G.P.M. respectively.

Application: Metering gasoline or other petroleum products for which it is calibrated in retail or wholesale trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894. The words "Reset counter to zero before delivery" must appear on the counter.

Description: These devices are non-computing gasoline dispensers basically the same as models CFF201 and CFF202 listed on SD-WA.251 except that an interlocking system similar to the system installed on model C996 SD-WA.18 has been incorporated in the assembly. A bull's eye sight glass has also been installed in the discharge line. The two models are identical except that the OFF202E-15 is equipped with a larger capacity pump.

Testing: apply.
