GILBERT AND BARKER - GASOLINE DISPENSER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensers, Models 44 and 44RC manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Company Limited, 64 Jefferson Avenue, Toronto 3, Ontario.

Application: Retail gasoline trade


Rating of Apparatus: 12 G. P. M. maximum flow

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894

Description: These devices are retail gasoline dispensers. The Model 44 is a self-contained unit with the main components the same as are incorporated in Model C-1006 on S-WA.258 except that the assembly has been made more compact allowing the overall height of the dispenser to be reduced to 44 inches. The Model 44RC is basically similar to 1006 RC (S-WA.293) except that the overall height has been cut down to 44 inches.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
