## APPROVAL LISTING

## GILBERT AND BARKER — GASOLINE DISPENSER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (F.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispenser with remote pumping unit Model 44XRC, manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Company Limited, 64 Jefferson Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: 12 G. P. M. maximum


Application: Metering gasoline in retail trade


Conditions: As prescribed in F.C. 6894 and the added requirement that on installation, the individual purchase totalizer is not located more than 66 inches above the roadway, nor less than 40 inches above the roadway adjacent to the island on which the dispenser is installed.

Description: This device is a gasoline dispenser with remote pumping unit and the interior mechanism is so arranged that the overall height of the cabinet is 30 inches to allow the unit to be installed on a display cabinet at a service station.

The standard 4 cylinder Gilbert and Barker meter is installed in the unit and the Veeder-Root computing unit is interlocked with the starting handle and the solenoid operated valve on the gasoline inlet line.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.
