## WAYNE - GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.


Apparatus Listed: Non-computing gasoline dispensers, Models 410-B, 410B2 and 410B-1 with capacities of 15 G.P.M., 25 G.P.M. and 15 G.P.M. respectively, manufactured by Wayne Pump Canada Ltd., 829 Richmond St., Toronto, Ontario.


Application: Metering gasoline in retail or wholesale trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894. NOTE: If dispenser is not equipped with visi gauge the unit is a wholesale device and is not legal for dispensing quantities less than 40 gallons and must be so marked.

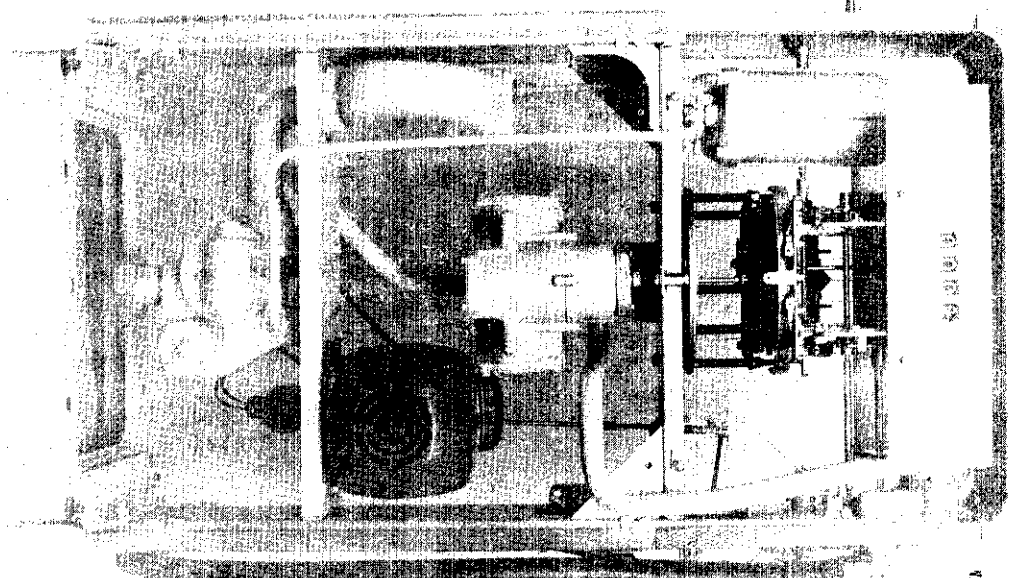
Description: This device is a non-computing dispenser which may or may not be equipped with a printer within the casing. The pump, strainer and pressure control valve are assembled as a compact unit. The air eliminator and float chamber are separate units and the model 21M3 meter is a two piston positive displacement type. Model 410B-1 is constructed for use with a remote submerged pump of standard Wayne design.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.

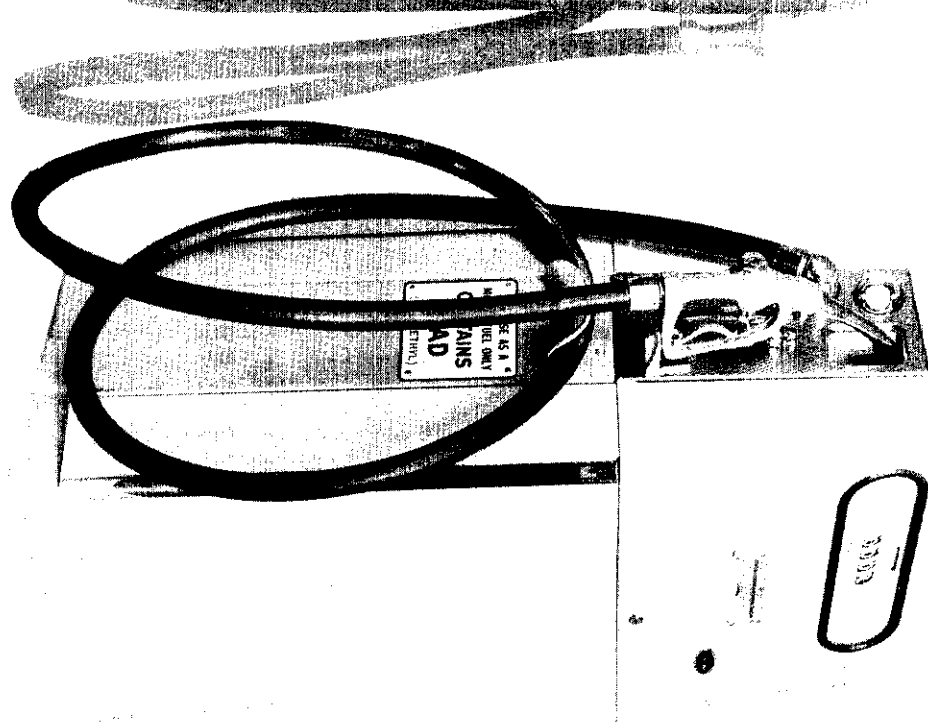
