BENNETT CASOLINE DISPENSER

Description:

This device is equipped with the same registering head, meter and ancillary equipment installed in the 2000 series dispensers listed on SD-WA. 357 except that the piping arrangement has been changed to accommodate the assembly to the inverted L casing design, and the registering head drive mechanism has been changed to a flexible drive.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gesoline dispenser shall apply.


