LOCKHEED - TICKET-PRINTING COMPUTING REGISTER

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952 and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed:

Ticket-printing computing register designed for use with approved bulk meters for tank truck delivery of fuel oils, models as listed below:-

Model 811 - with tax computer, external price changer and preset counter:

Model 812 - with tax computer and external price changer; Model 813 - with external price changer and preset counter; Model 814 - with external price changer.

Manufactured by the Lockheed Electronics Co., Metuchen, New Jersey, $U_*3_*\Lambda_*$

Rating of Apparatus: Designed for use with meters with capacities up to 120 G.P.M.

A Loation:

Designed for use in the retail petroleum product fields, e.g., for truck mounted meters delivering fuel to homes.

Description:

This register is the same as the series 800 Lockheed registers approved under S.WA-457, except that an external price changer has been incorporated. This changer is fully interlocked to ensure that the price during the delivery cannot be changed.

Testing:

The register must be installed prior to test and the meter and register shall be tested as a complete unit.

Standard tests for bulk meters shall apply.
