APPROVAL LISTINGGILBERT AND PARKER - GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, P.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6974), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus listed: Computing gasoline dispensers, high-gallonage type with 4-wheel computer, model numbers as follows:

104-210	Single suction pump type, lighted.
154-210	Single suction pump type, unlighted.


Rating of Apparatus: 18 G.P.M. maximum.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6974.

Applications: Retail gasoline trade.

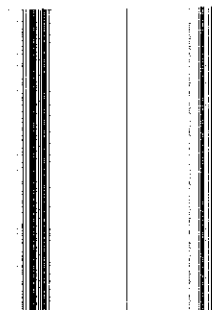
Description: The casing of this dispenser is similar to that of the Model 252-110 (dual) approved on SP-WA.459. The piping, hose and nozzle is 1-inch; the computer is the 4-wheel type. The internal components are essentially the same as in the high-gallonage model 100 2GH approved on SP-WA.328, except for the visi-gauge, which is the Venturi type used in the "Trimline" series. This dispenser may incorporate a Wix filter between the air separator and the meter.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.

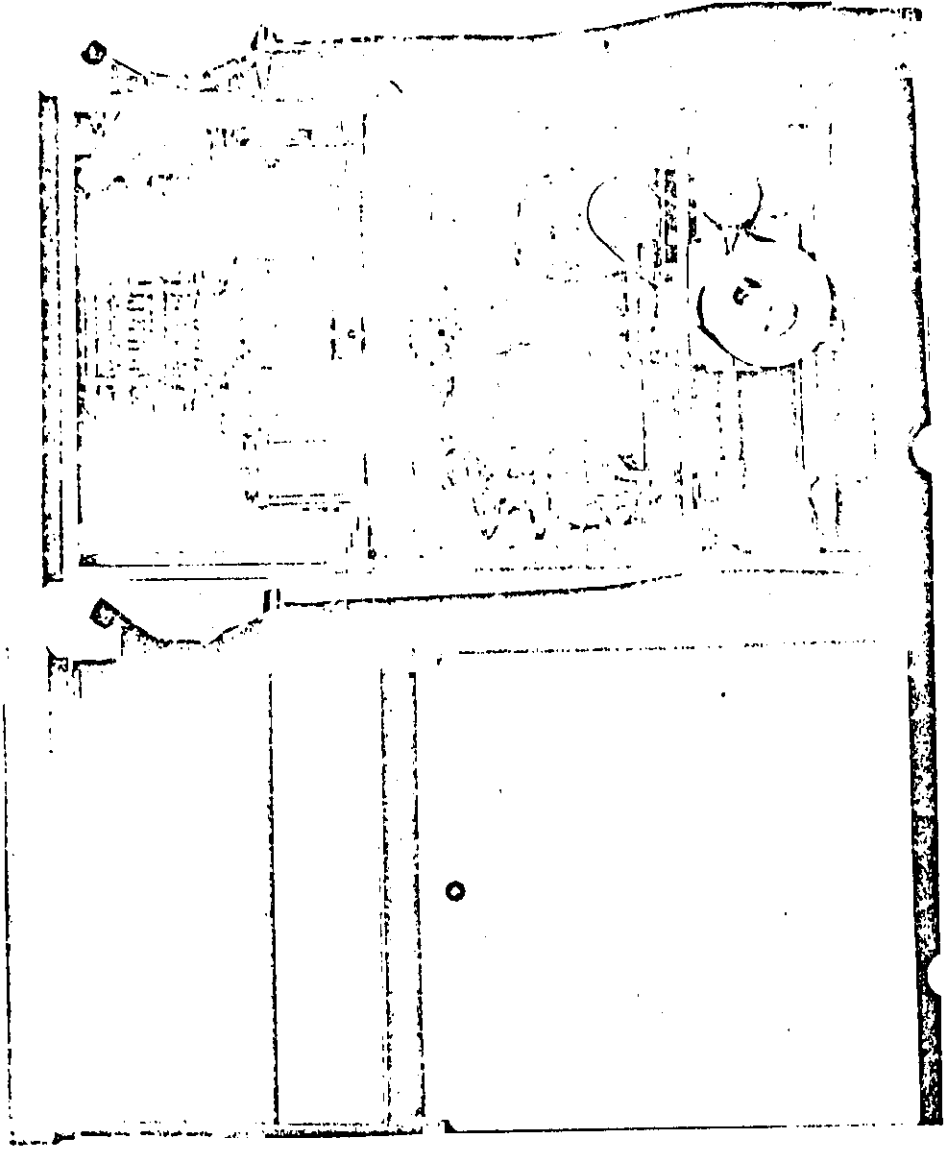

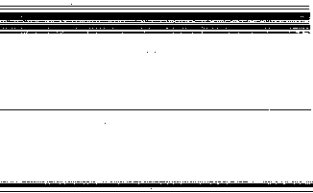
