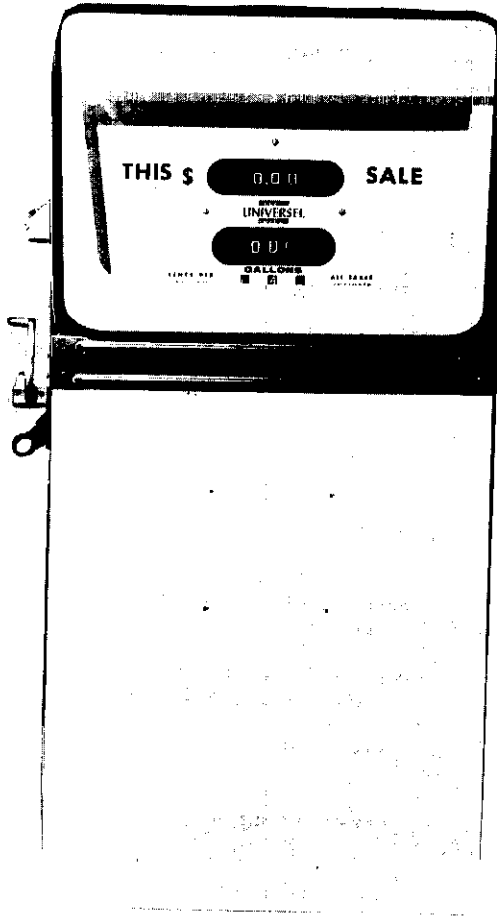
Apparatus Listed: Gasoline dispensers rebuilt under the direction of Astro Limited (Petroquip Limited) 60 Leslie Street, Toronto, Ontario. The dispensers will use the following new model numbers:

| 11BT | Single suction-pump type dispenser, using components from Bennett models 766, 966 and 1066. |
| 31GB | Single suction-pump type dispenser, using components from Gilbert and Barker models 906, 1002, 1004, and 1006. |
| 41W | Single suction-pump type dispenser, using components from Wayne models 100-A and 100-B. |
| 42W | Single suction-pump type dispenser, using components from Wayne models 500 and 505. |
| 17BT-RD | Single remote pump type dispenser, using components from Bennett model 952. |

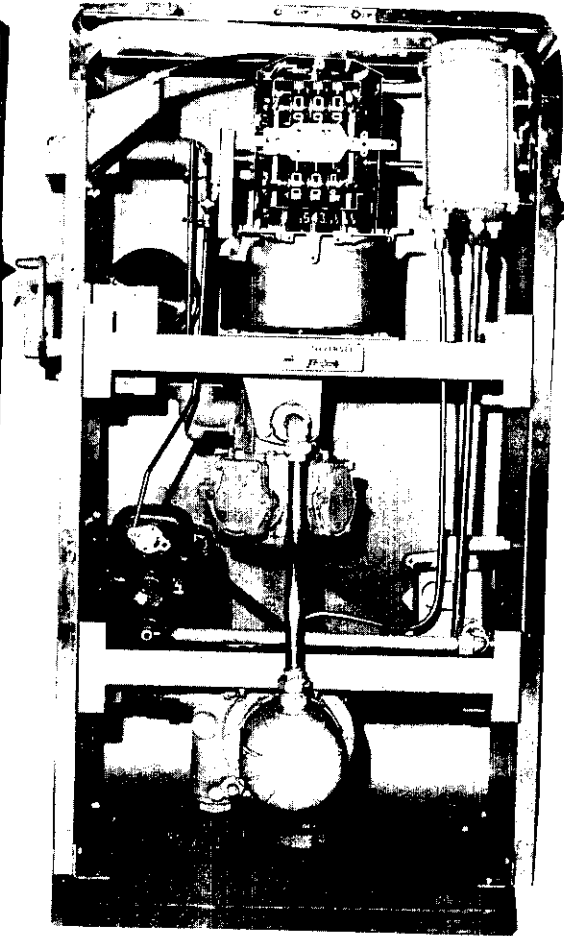
Lighted models are designated by the suffix "L" and are 6" higher than the unlighted. Astro Limited has appointed agents who are authorized to rebuild dispensers to standard Astro Universel designs. Refer to SWA.498 for the names of these agents and the serial number allocation.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum capacity 12 gpm.
Application: Retail gasoline trade.
Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6394.

Description:


This approval covers gasoline dispensers rebuilt by Astro Limited and by shops appointed by them. In general, components will be taken from units built in 1946 and later. These components will be thoroughly overhauled to perform substantially as well as new ones before being installed in new, modern cabinets supplied by Astro Limited. The components may be used only in the same combinations as in the original models, and components of different makes may not be used in the same dispenser.

Astro Limited will distribute photographs and drawings of approved models to their agents to ensure uniformity in assembly.

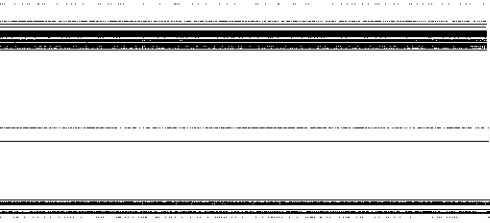
Testing:
