GILBERT AND BARKER - GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensers with suction and remote type pumps. These dispensers have been previously approved under SD-WA.459 but now, because of a change in the lighting system, the computer cabinet's appearance has been changed and new model numbers assigned as follows:

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum 15 gpm.


Application: Dispensing gasoline in retail trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Description: As mentioned above, these dispensers are identical to those approved on SD-WA.459, except that the part of the cabinet housing the computer has been redesigned to suit a different lighting arrangement. The arrangement of the internal components is exactly the same as before. The computer housing remains unchanged on the unlighted models in this series and the model numbers remain the same as on SD-WA.459.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
