GILBERT AND BARKER -- GASOLINE DISPENSERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing gasoline dispensers, high-gallonage type with 4-wheel computers, model numbers as follows:

164-310	Single, remote pump type, lighted
154-310	Single, remote pump type, unlighted

Manufactured by Gilbert and Barker Manufacturing Co. Ltd., 64 Jefferson Ave., Toronto, Ontario.


Rating of Apparatus: 17 gpm maximum.


Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

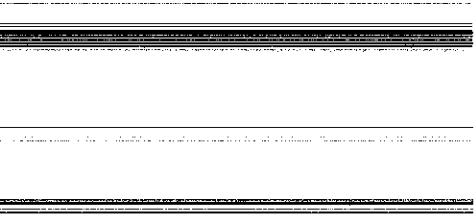
Description: The casing on these dispensers is identical in that on the C164-010 and C154-010 dispensers approved on S-WA.529 the internal arrangement of the components is the same. However, the piping, hose, and nozzle is 1-inch instead of 3/4-inch, and the computer is the 4-wheel type. The internal components are essentially the same as on high-gallonage model 1002GH approved on SD-WA.328; except that the visi-gauge is the Venturi type used in the "Trim-Line" series. Suction pump models of this style of dispenser have been approved on S-WA.513.

Testing: The standard test for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
