


Description:

These dispensers utilize the same T-shaped housing as used for the remanufactured units on SD-WA.554. A "Cam-Ac" interlock mechanism is used, and a redesigned full-flow see-gauge and a model 56 computer.

Testing:

The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
