WAYNE - "BLEND-O-MATIC" DISPENSER WITH EXTERNAL FILTERS

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein have been listed as approved devices and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Computing type dispensers for blending gasolines, the same models as previously approved, except now fitted with a Wix dual filter assembly:

<u>Model</u>	<u>Description</u>
511-DF	Blend-O-Matic with suction pumps.
511-DF-1	Blend-O-Matic with remote pumps.
511-E	Blend-O-Matic with suction pumps.
511-E-1	Blend-O-Matic with remote pumps.

Manufactured by: Wayne Pump Canada Ltd., 829 Richmond St. West, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum 15 gpm of blended or low grade gasoline; or 10 gpm maximum of concentrate.


Application: Retail gasoline trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894. This approval covers only Blend-O-Matic dispensers for the Sun Oil Company.

Description: The filter base is attached to the elbow to which the hose is normally connected. The two grades of gasoline are conducted through passages in the base to separate filters for the high and low grades, leave the filter base in two separate streams, enter the hose-within-a-hose, and finally mix at the nozzle.

Testing: The standard tests for a Blend-O-Matic gasoline dispenser shall apply.
