Description: The housing for these dispensers is quite different from the previously approved Model 4800 on S-WA.386, in that the cabinets are wider to accommodate twin units, but are shorter in keeping with the trend toward lower dispensers. Both the gear and blade type pumping units are used in these models.

Testing: The standard tests for a retail gasoline dispenser shall apply.




