Model Description 140B Single suction pump, single hose, computing type gasoline dispenser; uses overhauled working components from Bowser model 575. 140BT As above, except uses overhauled working components from Bennett model 956. 140GB As above, except uses overhauled working components from Gilbarco model 996. 140T As above, except uses overhauled working components from Tokheim model 39-B. 140W As above, except uses overhauled working components from Wayne model 500. Single Double suction pumps, two hoses, computing type 240B-Dual 02 gasoline dispenser; uses overhauled working components from Bowser model S-22. 540 As above, except uses overhauled working components from Gilbarco model 296. Juro products 24GB-Dual 02 240W-Dual 01 Single suction pump, two hoses, computing type gasoline dispenser; uses overhauled working components from Wayne model 70.

Rating of Apparatus: Maximum capacity 12 gpm.

Application: Retail gasoline trade.

<u>Description</u>: These dispensers use all the working components of the original dispenser, except for the sight glass, and they are installed in the new housing in the same arrangement as in the old. The components are thoroughly overhauled to perform substantially as well as new ones.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
