The dispensers listed herein have the dispenser hose connection and the sight glass installed near the upper level of the register cabinet rather than at the lower level. Otherwise, they are identical with the A.O. Smith models listed on S.WA-465.

TESTING: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.




