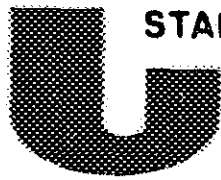

Approved: GASBOY - KEY-CONTROLLED GASOLINE DISPENSERS

manufactured by: Gasboy of Canada Limited, London, Ontario.

Apparatus Listed: Non-computing type gasoline dispensers, with key-controlled subsidiary totalizers:

<u>Model</u>	<u>Description</u>
52	With 1/3 hp motor for 14 gpm max.
53	With 3/4 hp motor for 20 gpm max.

Application: Self-serve dispensing of gasoline and diesel fuel to motor vehicles in retail and wholesale trade.

Description: These dispensers are the trade version of Gasboy dispensers previously sold only for non-trade use. The non-trade version used a rotating disk type of meter, whereas the approved model uses the Gilbarco meter, pumping unit and Wayne air eliminator.

Up to 50 key-controlled individual customers' totalizers may be installed. The totalizer in use must be exposed to the view of the customer, therefore the shutters normally hiding the totalizers are to be sealed open with W. & M. seals.

Testing: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.
