All of the above meters may be equipped with a preset register in addition to the usual indicating register and ticket printer. Models MA-5 and MA-7 may be equipped with a Series 42700 automatic temperature compensator (range -30°F to +120°F for use when metering liquified petroleum gases. All meter models have casings of aluminum.

NOTE: Some of above-listed meters may have been marked with Approval No. S.WA-919 on earlier installations.

APPLICATION: The metering of liquid petroleum products in trade, Models MA-5 and MA-7 may also be used for the metering of liquified gases.

DESCRIPTION: These meters are rotary positive displacement type, utilizing the same style and arrangement of metering elements and calibrator as used on the series of LC meters earlier approved on S.WA-739.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: Meters installed on tank trucks shall be equipped with the combination strainer/air release supplied with the meter. Metres at bulk plants may, in addition, require a bulk-type deaerator, particularly if supplied by suction-type pumps.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: (Continued)

Meters to be used for liquified gases shall also be equipped with a back pressure/differential pressure valve and a well for a test thermometer, and shall be installed and used in accordance with the Ministerial Specification entitled "Specification for the Installation and Use of Meters for LPG."

TESTING: The standard tests for bulk meters shall apply.


