401	Keytrol unit mounted on side of cabinet
455	"Sensor Safe" leak detector switch

DESCRIPTION: The top part of the cabinet for these dispensers  
is the same as for the corresponding model in the 4200  
series of S.WA-683, but the lower part is the same as for  
the 4000 series of S.WA-808.

Dispensers supplied by remote pumps may optionally  
incorporate the "Sensor-Safe" leak detector switch, which is  
a safety feature that cannot effect the accuracy of measurement.

TESTING: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply.


