WAYNE - DISPENSERS FOR USE WITH POSTPAY SYSTEMS

MANUFACTURED BY: Wayne Pump Division, Canada.

DEVICES LISTED: Computing type gasoline dispensers for use with self-serve postpay systems, basic models as listed below:

<u>Model No.</u>	<u>Original S.WA Nos</u>	<u>Description</u>
730	673 and 460	Suction pump, one hose
732	673 and 460	Suction pump, two hoses
733	673 and 460	Suction pumps, two products
734	673 and 445	Suction pump, single hose
760	673 and 515	Suction pumps; blender

The postpay feature is designated by the suffix -15 added to the model number. The following prefixes and suffixes may also be used:

<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Suffix</u>
E- electric reset	-B flow indicator
1E- Postpay money counter	-G filter
2E- Postpay gallon counter	-yy pulser
	-1 remote pump
	-2 high capacity


DESCRIPTION: The dispensers are almost identical to the originally approved models, the only difference being the addition of a pulser or pulsers to transmit gallonage and/or money value to the secondary register(s) on the cashier's console and the installation of a solenoid to operate the computer reset. The operation of the dispenser and the dispenser interlocks are the same as on an attendant-operated unit.

MARKING: All dispensers incorporating the postpay feature shall have installed on each dial face a permanent legend "in case of disagreement between this register and the cashier's register, this register shall be taken as correct" in letters at least 3/16" high.

TESTING: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply. There is no need to seal the register on the cashier's console, as legally the money-value register on the dispenser is the basis for the sale.
