DEVICES LISTED: Computing type gasoline dispensers, primarily for use in self-serve operations; models as listed below:

830	Suction pump, one hose
832	Suction pump, two hoses
833	Suction pumps, two products
830-1	Remote pump, one hose
832-1	Remote pump, two hoses
833-1	Remote pumps, two products

When these dispensers are equipped for use with self-serve postpay systems, the suffix -15 is added to the above model numbers. The following prefixes and suffixes may also be used:

<u>Prefix</u>	<u>Suffix</u>
E- electric reset	-B flow indicator
1E- postpay money counter	-G filter
2E- postpay gallon counter	-YY pulser
	-1 remote pump
	-2 high capacity

DESCRIPTION: These dispensers are identical to the corresponding models in the 700 series except that the sight glass and hose are connected to a rotating radial arm, and a rocker-type switch is used. These two features are designed to simplify dispenser operation, particularly at self-serve installations.



MARKING: All dispensers incorporating the postpay feature shall have installed on each dial face a permanent legend "in case of disagreement between this register and the cashier's register, this register shall be taken as correct" in letters at least 3/16" high.

TESTING: The standard tests for a gasoline dispenser shall apply. There is no need to seal the cashier's register on the console associated with postpay systems, as legally the sale is on the basis of the verified dispenser.
