DEVICE APPROVED: Gilbarco Transac 11 electronic cashier's console and accessories for use in self-serve gasoline dispenser operations, in conjunction with Gilbarco Highline 111B dispensers.

APPLICATION: For use in self-serve gasoline dispensing systems.

DESCRIPTION: This sytem utilizes a cashier's console that, on a LCD display, indicates sale money and volume registration (selectively, one at a time) for up to 12 gasoline dispensers and permits the operator to maintain control of operation of the dispensers. The console also has provision for displaying total volume and cash sales for individual dispensers and for the complete station.

The console receives sale volume and money data from the electronic computing register of the Highline lllB dispenser. The console itself also incorporates a microprocessor, which has memory capabilities and which serves to complete the processing of data received from the dispenser. Interface between the console and all dispensers under its control is by means of a distribution box which contains the distribution printed circuit board, terminal connections for two wire interface with the console, individual dispenser isolate switches, and a terminal strip for the two wire connections to each dispenser being controlled.

The console has the customary complement of controls and indicators, providing for optional prepay or postpay operation. The mode of operation is the same as for Gilbarco Transac 8 which is approved on S.WA-964.

MARKING: On self-serve dispensers there shall be installed on each dial face a permanent legend in letters at least 3/16" high and reading as follows:

"In case of disagreement between this register and the cashier's register, this register shall be taken as correct." or "Charges must agree with this register."

TESTING: The standard tests for self-serve gasoline dispensers shall apply.
