Type of Device - Refuellers for trucks and road tractors, as previously approved, except equipped Veeder-Root model 101 computing type registers modified as follows:

Description: The R.H. money wheel is covered with a mylar tape marked 00, 10, 20 - 90 (cents) and with 100 divisions around the wheel. The graduation lines at the marked (cardinal) graduations are longer, and so are those at the graduations representing 05, 15, ... 95 cents.

The R.H. volume wheel is covered with a mylar tape marked 0, 1, 2 ... 9 (litres) with 100 subdivisions around the wheel. The graduation lines at the marked (cardinal) graduations are longer, and so are those that represent 0.5, 1.5 ... 9.5 litres.

One rotation of the money wheel represents one dollar and one rotation of the volume wheel represents 10 litres.

Conditions: The tape must be an accurate fit, with the overlap or gap between ends not to exceed 1 millimetre. A sample of the tape is to be forwarded to the Chief, Weights and Measures for approval.

Authorized for use only on refuellers operating at not more than 200 litres per minute. Each face of the register to have a permanent legend in letters 5mm high "Minimum Delivery 200 Litres".
