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DESCRIPTION: The dispensers are almost identical to approved Post-Pay models, the only difference being the addition of a solenoid valve to accomplish slowdown (approx. 1 gpm) to ensure accurate shutoff at the preset amount. The operation of the dispenser and the dispenser interlocks are the same as on attended or Post-Pay models. Upon flow shutoff at preset the amount, no additional flow can be obtained until the dispenser is turned off, control console reauthorized, computer returned to zero and dispenser restarted. These dispensers can be used with cashiers' consoles similar to those on SWA-1115, SWA-1116, etc.

MARKING: All dispensers incorporating the Pre-Pay feature shall have installed on each dial face a permanent legend "in case of disagreement between this register and the cashier's register, this register shall be taken as correct" in letters at least 3/16" high. Only the original SWA number need appear on the dispenser.

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
